



# Hours of Operation Sign Installation Instructions

## Items included in this package:

(1) Blank grid

(3) Number sheets

- Your hours of operation sign is designed to stick to the outside of a glass window or door.
- Glass must be clean and free of any wax, oil or dirt.
- The adhesive used on the sign will remain effective at temperatures to 20 below zero. However, application of material should be done at temperatures above 35 degrees. If you want to apply the sign at temperatures below 35, simply warm glass with a hair dryer immediately before installation.

## Installation

1. Choose location for installation of hours sign.
2. Clean glass thoroughly and allow it to dry.
3. Lay sign on a smooth, clean, dry surface.
4. Choose appropriate numbers from number sheets and apply to days of week grid to correspond with your hours of operation.
5. Once hours are placed as necessary, double-check for accuracy.
6. Fold back 1"–2" of liner sheet at top of sign.
7. Carefully align the sign on glass and stick the exposed 1"–2" of adhesive on the glass.
8. Carefully burnish the material to the glass, working left and right of center.
9. Once top of sign is adhered, gradually peel the liner down while burnishing the sign to the window.

## Care

Wipe sign with soft, damp cloth as needed to remove dirt and fingerprints.
