INSTALLING SHELVES AND DOORS

SHELVES

Tempered glass is strengthened safety glass, but will shatter if a corner hits a hard surface. Please be very careful while handling the shelves and doors.

For each shelf there are shelf supports in the frame at the four corners of the case. They are already installed at their standard height and can be adjusted based on your preference.

- 1. If necessary, adjust the shelf supports to your desired height. Manually turning a support counterclockwise will loosen the support and allow you to slide the support to any height you want. At the desired height, tighten the support so it will remain at that height.
- 2. Starting with the bottom supports CAREFULLY put the shelves inside the case and lay them on the shelf supports. You may want to set a round item on the shelf to confirm that the supports are level.
- 3. If you are not happy with the level of the shelf, please remove the shelf and adjust the supports as described above.
- 4. Repeat for each shelf.

SLIDING GLASS DOORS

- 1. Take the door WITHOUT THE LOCK and carefully insert the glass edge into the INNER track along the top cabinet. Bring the metal shoe over the INNER track and place it so the wheels are sitting on the inner rail.
- 2. Adjust how the door sits on the rails until both wheels roll easily along them. When done, slide this door to the far left.
- Take the door WITH THE LOCK and carefully insert the glass edge into the OUTER rail. The door should be oriented so that the lock is in the upper left corner and its screws are facing inside the case. Bring the metal shoe over the OUTER track and place it so the wheels are sitting on the OUTER rail.
- 4. Adjust how the door sits on the rails until both wheels roll easily along them. When done, slide this door to the far right.
- 5. You should now be able to lock the doors by sliding the enclosed plunger lock key into the keyhole, turning the key and removing the key. The lock tip will remain in the hole, locking the doors.
